- V. 12 THE NEXT DAY THE LARGE CROWD THAT HAD COME TO THE FEAST HEARD THAT JESUS WAS COMING TO JERUSALEM.
- V. 13 SO THEY TOOK BRANCHES OF PALM TREES AND WENT OUT TO MEET HIM, CRYING OUT, "HOSANNA! BLESSED IS HE WHO COMES IN THE NAME OF THE LORD, EVEN THE KING OF ISRAEL!"
- V. 14 AND JESUS FOUND A YOUNG DONKEY AND SAT ON IT, JUST AS IT IS WRITTEN,

- V. 26 IF ANYONE SERVES ME, HE MUST FOLLOW ME; AND WHERE I AM, THERE WILL MY SERVANT BE ALSO. IF ANYONE SERVES ME, THE FATHER WILL HONOR HIM.
- V. 27 NOW IS MY SOUL TROUBLED. AND WHAT SHALL I SAY? 'FATHER, SAVE ME FROM THIS HOUR'? BUT FOR THIS PURPOSE I HAVE COME TO THIS HOUR.
